- PLUS system requirements



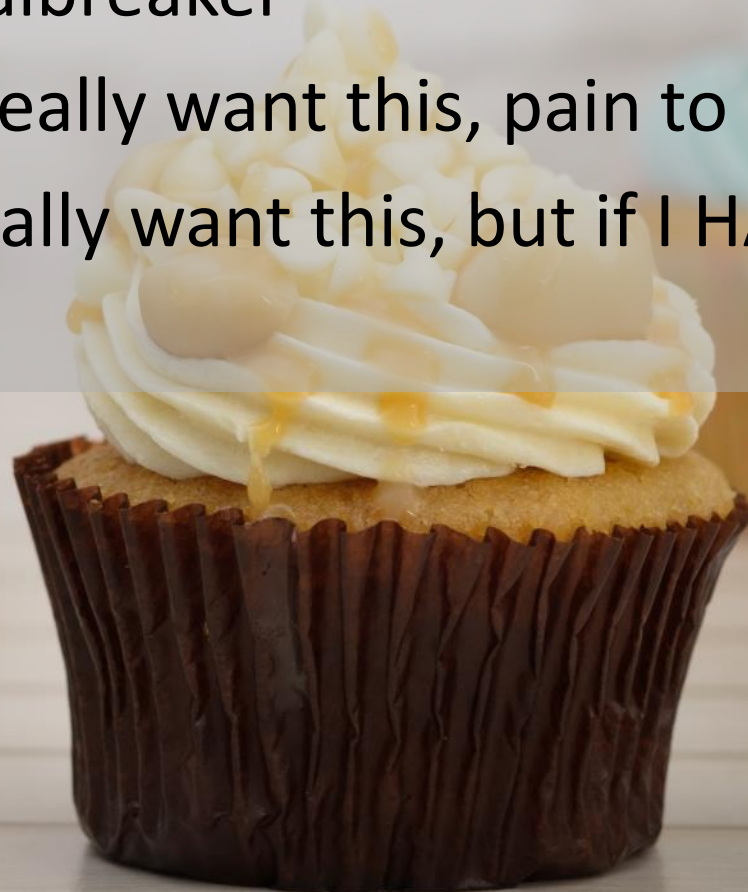

Go with the flow

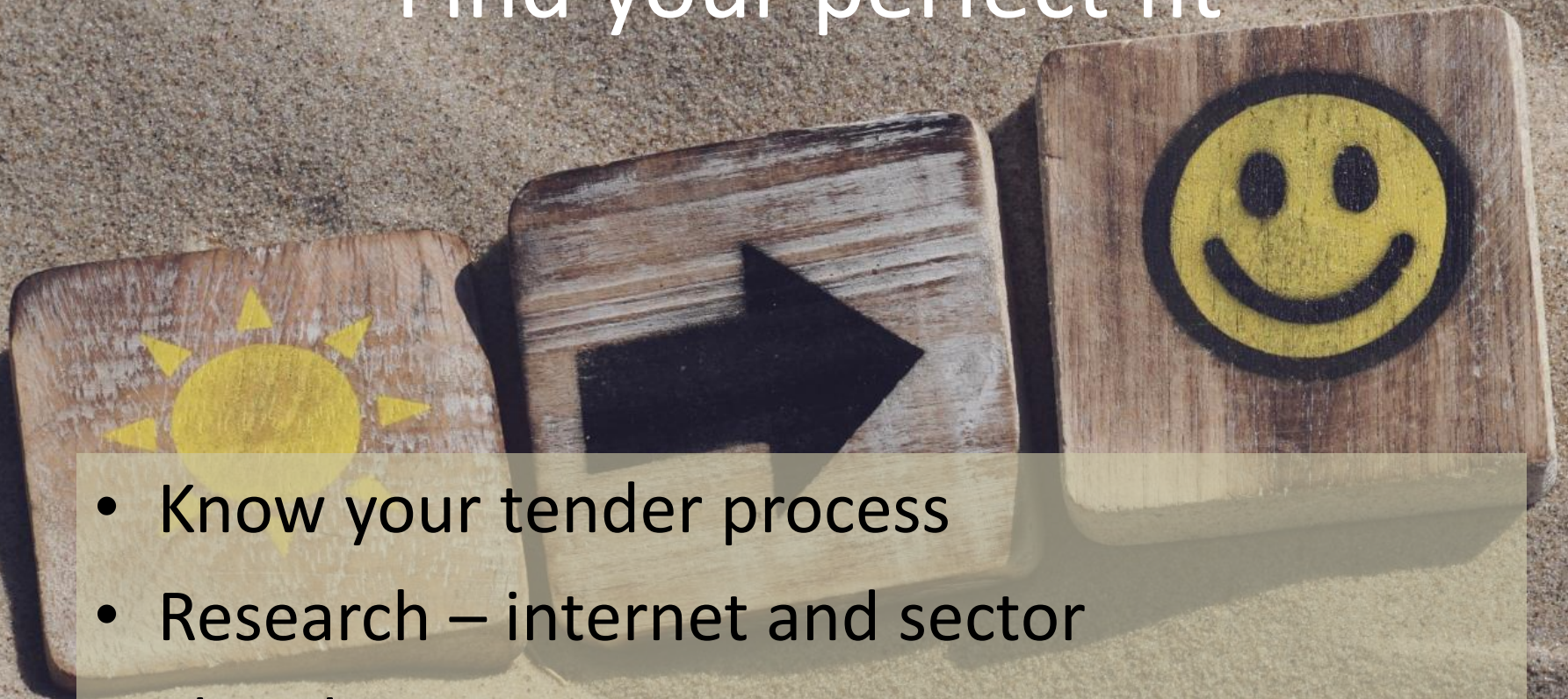
- Map your key processes

Find your perfect fit

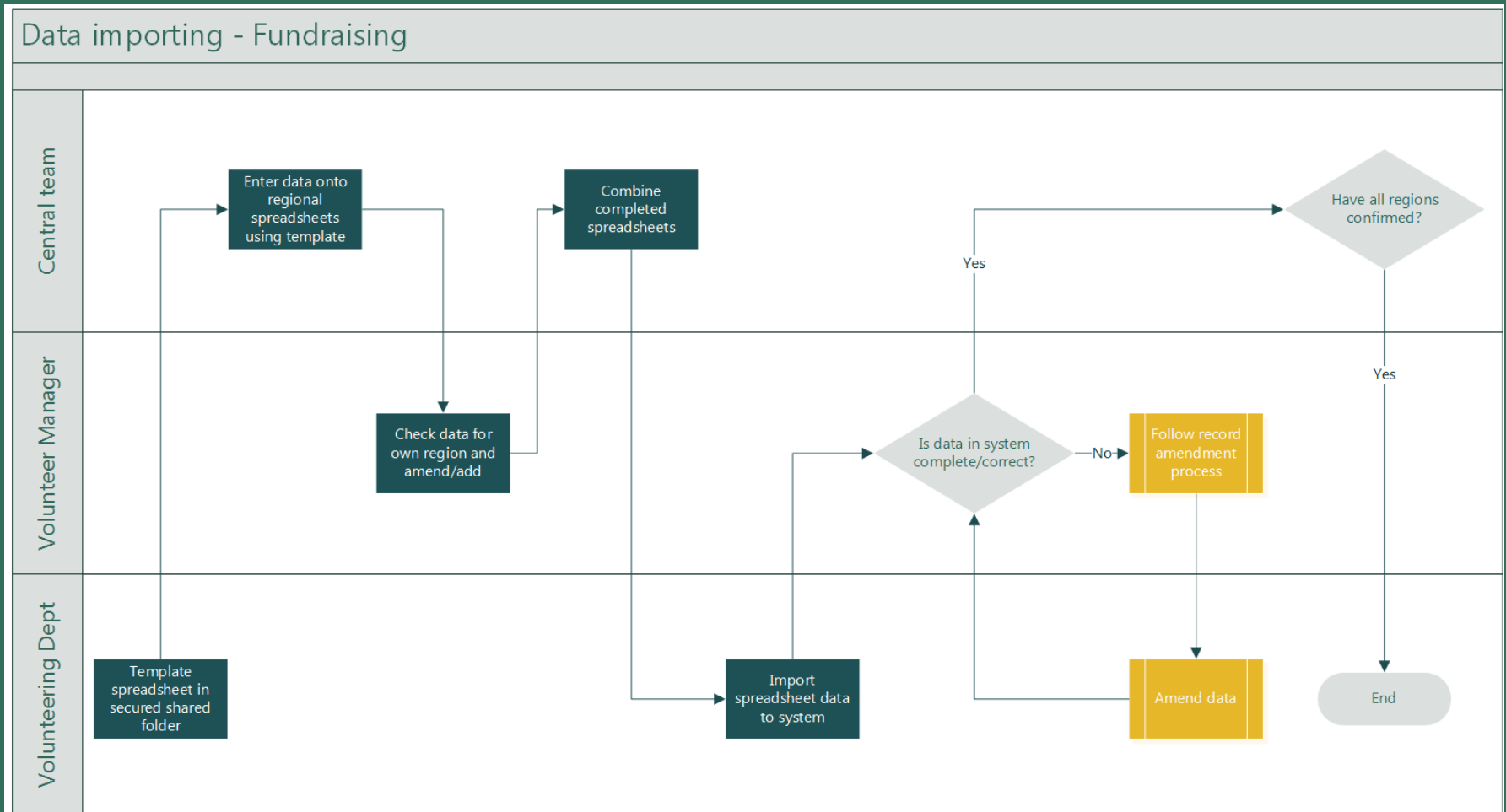


- Know your tender process
